Contribution of the Portuguese government and society

- In the end of October of 2016, Portugal received a total of 1,100 refugees, that were distributed in more than 100 municipalities around the country.
- RNAIM was also created to support the complex process of receiving new refugees.
- The creation of the CPR, which is a non-profit independent organization.
 - This organization is responsible for the reception and resettlement of new refugees arriving in the country.
 - It provides support and several integration techniques.



Contribution on the Educational system

- In 2016, the ministry of education created the measures to be implemented in the education system:
 - equivalence of school qualifications;
 - providing mechanisms to respond to the effective needs of pupils in the field of language learning in the host country, in order to allow a systematic contact with the educational community, in particular with the students in the class in which they will be integrated.



The school's contribution

- The grouping of schools of São João da Talha is a reference point for the reception of foreign refugees, having over 150 foreign students from more than 10 different countries.
- There's the EPIS program, a team specially dedicated to promote school success that collaborates with multidisciplinary teams.
